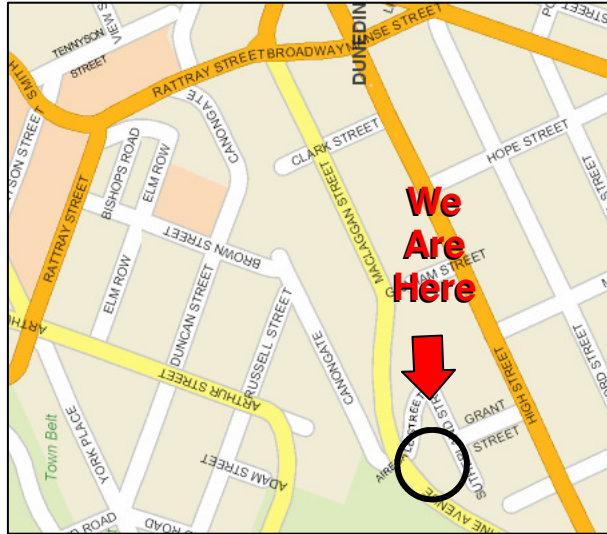

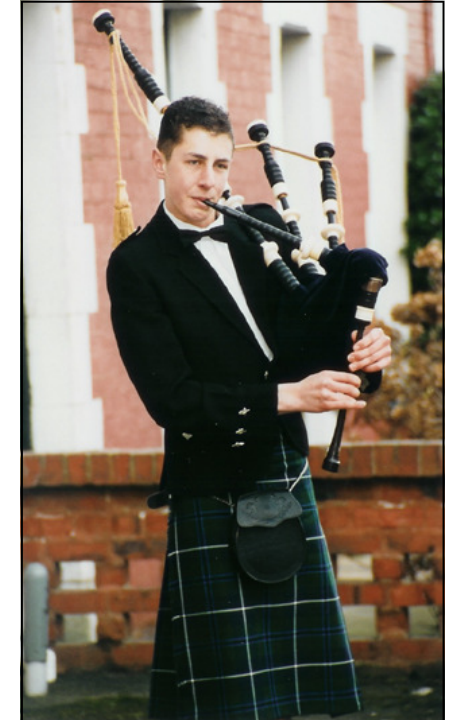

The **Otago School of Piping** would like to present the Bagpipe Stage 3 course.

This is a course of bagpipe tuition that concentrates on solo competition tunes and bagpipe examinations.

At the completion of the course you will be ready to graduate to Stage 4 Bagpipes.

Curriculum

The course will cover these topics:

- Learning these competition tunes:
 - 2/4 March
 - Slow March
 - Strathspey and Reel
 - 6/8 March
- Competition technique
- Elementary Exam Material

Pre-requisites:

In order to be ready for this course you will have the following:

1. Completed Stage 2 Bagpipes to the satisfaction of your tutor.
2. Competed in the chanter event at a solo competition
3. Completed the Preliminary Piping Exam.
4. Can competently play the bagpipes with at least 2 drones.
5. Own your own set of Bagpipes.

What happens after this course?

It is up to you to decide what you would like to do after this course. We recommend that you consult with your tutor as to the best path for you. We expect that most will go on to the Stage 4 course that covers advanced solo competition techniques and examinations.

Course Details

During this course you will be expected to complete the following:

1. Complete a **Novice March** on the Solo Board.
2. Complete a **4 parted D Grade 2/4 March** on the Solo Board.
3. Complete a **2 parted D Grade Slow March** on the Solo Board.
4. Complete a **4 parted D grade Strathspey & Reel** on the Solo Board.
5. Complete a **4 parted C grade 6/8 March** on the Solo Board.
6. **WIN** any novice or **D grade event** at solo competition.
7. Complete the **Elementary Piping Exam**

Commitment Required?

You will be required to attend the following:

- 1-2 x band practices per week (band fees apply)
- 1 x One-on-One 1 hour lesson per week

Course Fees

The course fees cover the cost of the tutors and the course materials for the duration of the course.

 - ★ Drone Stoppers or Moose Valves
- Clear File for Storing Music
